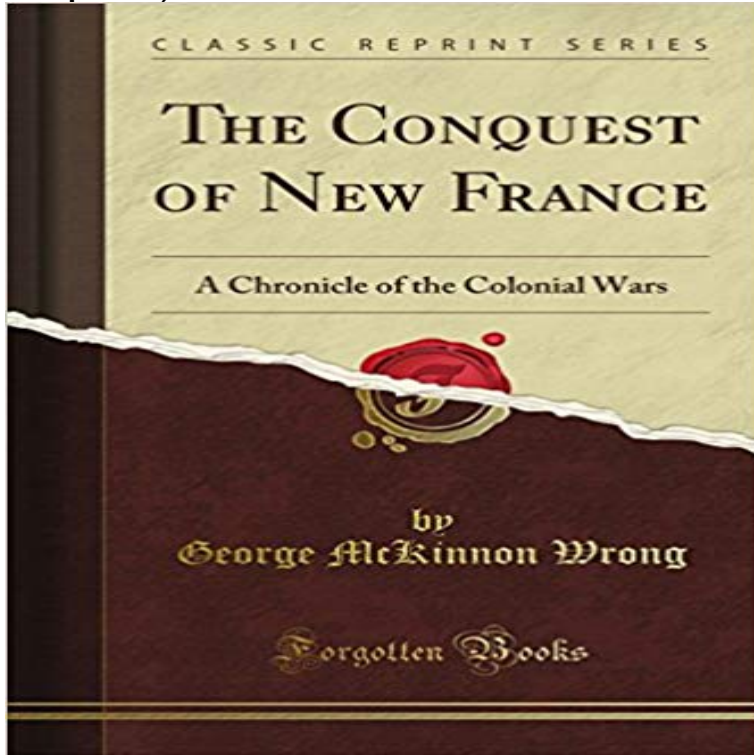


The Conquest of New France: A Chronicle of the Colonial Wars (Classic Reprint)
