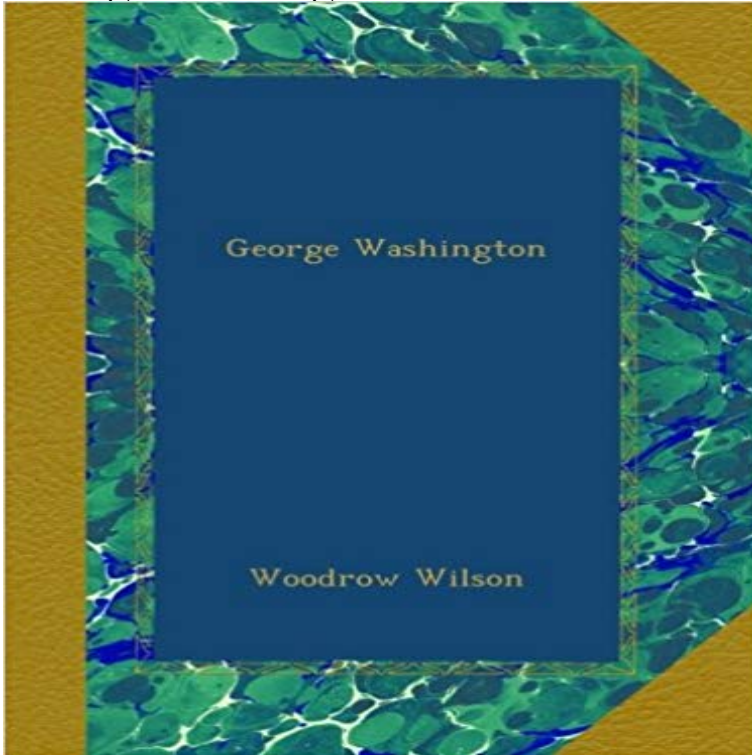


George Washington
