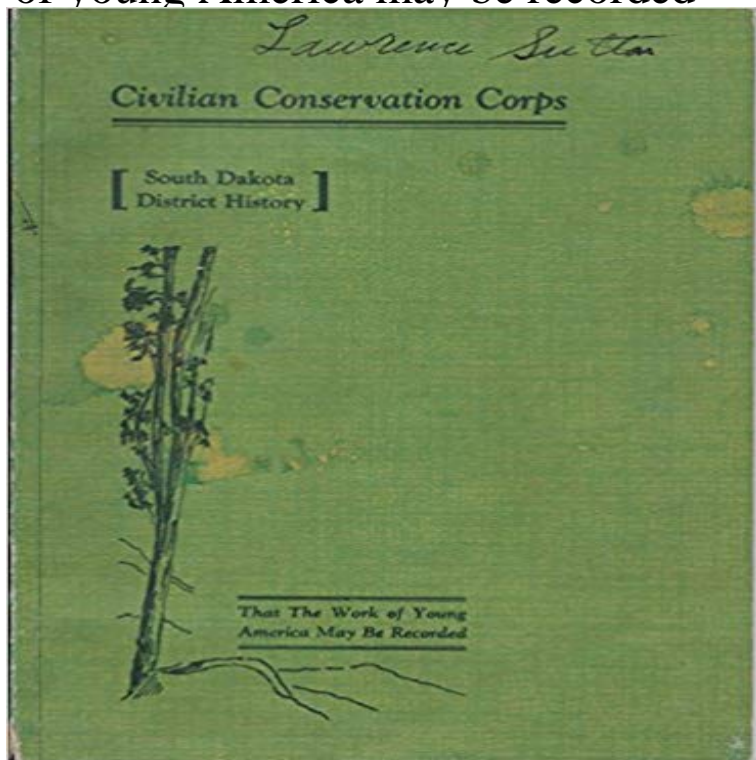


Civilian conservation corps, South Dakota district history: That the work of young America may be recorded
