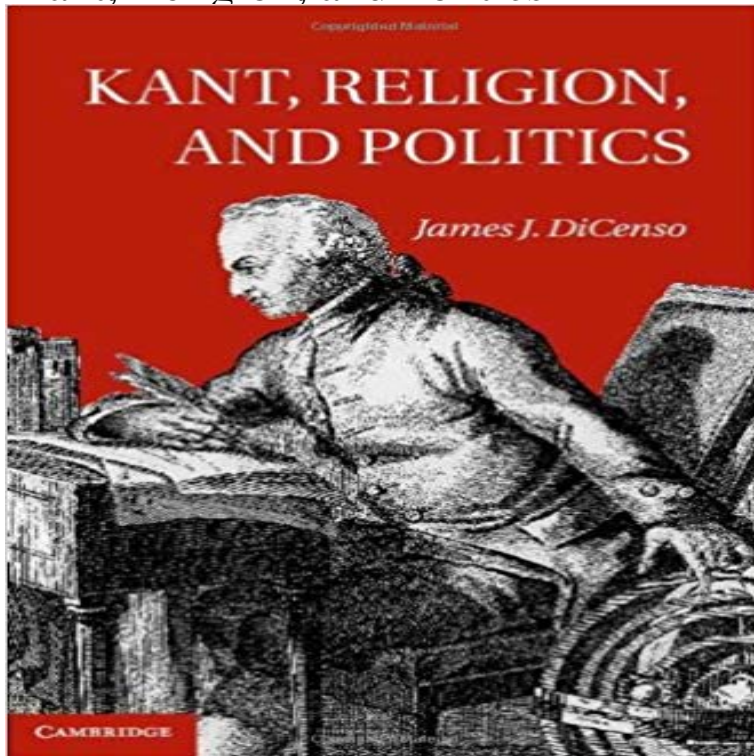


Kant, Religion, and Politics
