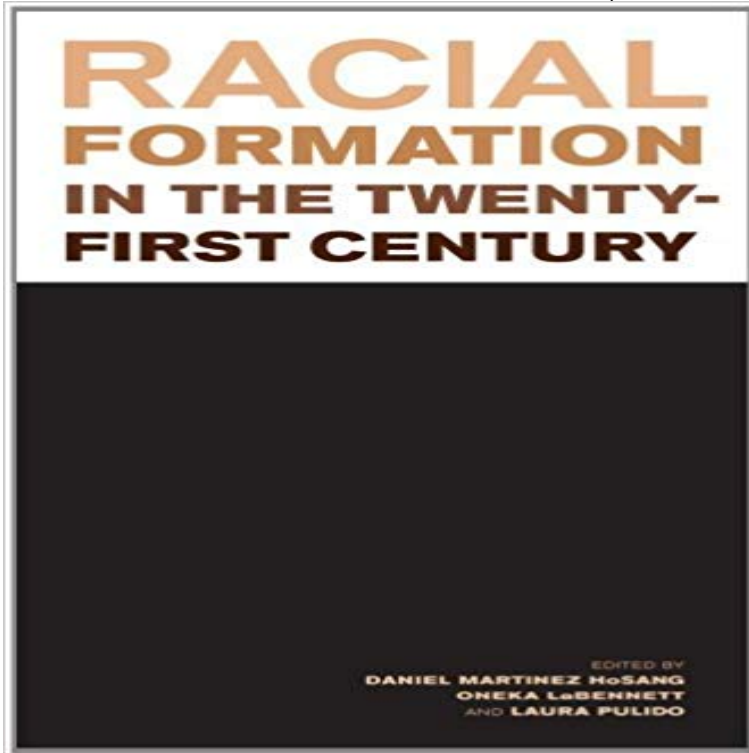


Racial Formation in the Twenty-First Century
